

Women's Bible Study FAQs



When is Bible Study?

Bible Study will meet on Thursdays from 6:30-8:00pm.

Our Fall Session will run 8 weeks, beginning Thursday, September 17th. We will be off for Fall Break on Thursday, October 15th. The last meeting of the fall session will be on Thursday, November 12th.

Who is Bible Study for?

Bible Study is open to adult women from every season of life. Whether you're new to studying Scripture or have spent years in God's Word, we'd love for you to join us.

Do I need prior Bible knowledge?

Not at all. No prior knowledge is required. Our goal is to help women grow in their understanding of God's Word, wherever they are starting from.

What is the format of Bible Study?

Women will use questions provided in a workbook to guide them through their individual study of Scripture. Weekly meetings will consist of a small group discussion with a consistent group of women and a large group time of teaching.

What will we study?

We study through books of the Bible, seeking to understand what God has revealed about Himself through His Word and how that truth shapes our lives. This fall, we'll be studying Exodus chapters 1-15.

How much homework is there?

The weekly study is designed to be manageable and flexible. Most women spend approximately 30-60 minutes over the course of the week completing the lesson, though you are free to spend more or less time as your schedule allows.

What if I miss a week?

We understand that life happens. While regular attendance helps build consistency and community, you are welcome to return whenever you are able.

Do I need to be a member of Redemption Church?

No. Bible Study is open to any woman who would like to attend.

Is childcare available?

Yes. Childcare will be provided for children from birth through 5th grade.

What if I've never studied the Bible before?

You're in good company. Many women join Bible Study with little or no experience studying Scripture. Our desire is to create a welcoming environment where women can learn, ask questions, and grow together in God's Word.

What if I can't finish the lesson every week?

That's okay. While completing the study will help you get the most out of the discussion and teaching, we know that some weeks are busier than others. Come anyway. Our hope is not perfection, but consistent engagement with God's Word over time.

Can I attend with a friend?

Absolutely. We encourage women to invite friends, neighbors, coworkers, and family members to join them. Bible Study is open to any woman who would like to attend on any given week.

Will I be expected to speak during discussion?

Participation is encouraged, but no one will be pressured to speak. Some women are comfortable sharing right away, while others prefer to listen at first. Our small groups are designed to be welcoming spaces where women can engage at their own pace.

How are small groups assigned?

You will be given your small group assignment on the first day of study. We will do our best to accommodate any special requests. (The earlier you register, the more likely we will be able to do so!)

What if I have questions during the week?

Questions are a normal part of studying Scripture. You're welcome to bring them to your small group discussion, connect with your group leader, or follow up with the teacher. We want Bible Study to be a place where women can learn and grow together.

What if I'm new to Redemption Church?

You are welcome here! Bible Study is a great place to meet other women, build relationships, and become more connected to the life of the church.

What if I don't know anyone?

Come anyway! Our small groups are intentionally designed to help women connect, and you'll quickly find that you're not alone.

What is the goal of Bible Study?

Our goal is not simply to gain information, but to know God more clearly through His Word and to be shaped by His truth over time. As we study Scripture together, we grow in our understanding of who God is, what He has done, and how He calls us to live.
